I received a text yesterday from "BNZ" saying "there had been a suspicious login attempt today and if it was NOT me I should click the link below". Another scam as I don't bank with BNZ."

This is the 3rd different scam reported recently, please let your neighbours know.

Great to see that there are still a lot of NZers out on holiday in our area...not so good to see we had 3 drink drivers last week.

How people drink alcohol then drive without getting organised and having a driver or using a courtesy van is appalling, dangerous and needs to stop.

Getting caught drink driving results in getting disqualified and a fine (or worse if previous offending) and then if you get caught driving while disqualified your car gets impounded for 28 days and it costs over \$400 to get it back, and you get fined and disqualified for longer.
