On 4th June a known burglar was seen in the Brooklyn area so please be alert and keep valuables locked away out of sight.

Overnight on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2 x red kayaks were stolen from a Tahi St address in Mapua. There have been reports of a vehicle seen driving in Mapua at about 3am on 7<sup>th</sup> June with 2 red kayaks on the roof but no vehicle description at this time.

Early evening 6<sup>th</sup> June a vehicle was broken into at the carpark at the end of Staples St, cash and groceries taken. Entry gained by smashing the ½ window.

Overnight on 7<sup>th</sup> June a car battery has been taken from a vehicle parked in High St. The vehicle was locked, the offender has damaged the lock to obtain entry.
