1. The rocks placed near the entrance haven't been placed yet. When will these arrive?.

Rocks are in Brightwater and I am getting a traffic management plan to drop them off as I was unable to off load them a few weeks back.

2. The picnic table for the south east corner by the conifer tree to give clear parent vision of both the playground and skate park hasn't been installed. Any idea when this will occur?

I was informed yesterday that this seat and the childs seat is ready to be picked up from the menz shed so I will get these in asap

3. I noticed the areas around both conifer trees have not had the grass completely removed nor has bark been placed around the trees. If this is not done these areas will become messy and hard to maintain. When will this be attended to?

Due to protecting the trees we did not remove all the grass around the trees but we will treat and put more bark around when we do the planting. Nelmac are going to put some plantings in for me once the rocks are in.

4. The single bar of three differing heights to replace the one the was damaged upon removal has not been placed yet. When is the likely to occur?

The bars are made but I put a hold on the installation as I need to re check all the distances. I may only end up putting one or two bars in

5. Have you an eta on when the wet area will be poured?

Wet pour has been delayed and now booked in for the 15<sup>th</sup> June

The fence between playground and road is fine. There are no requirements or standards for fencing
