Transportation /Well Being/Māpua Willing Wheels	Community Transport Māpua Willing Wheels supported by MDCA & Nelson Tasman Community Transport Trust has now been operating under the co-ordination of Rachel Mason for a year. Funding for this position has been accessed from MSD; Mapua Community Trust and the RATA Foundation. There are 12 voluntary drivers and passenger numbers are slowly increasing month by month. Information about this service and testimonials from users/drivers can be found on MDCA's facebook site.  Community Hub The possible transformation of "The Old Church" in Aranui Road into a Community Hub has been advancing this past year including formalising a governance relationship between the Māpua Community Wellbeing Trust(MCWT) and the Working Group. An initial building inspection and suggestions from an architect have provided a rough idea of potential costs. Funding from the Māpua & Districts Community Grant scheme supported a data gathering process of the numbers and requirements of potential hub users. This data has also formed the basis of an online community directory on the MDCA Website page as well as being part of the requirements for a feasibility study.
