Hello Neighbourhood Supporters, Group Contacts and Schools, the latest report follows, for distribution please to your neighbours. Also note that the scam email purporting to come from the NZ Transport Agency is still doing the rounds.

NB. This police report is not for publication on any social media site.

Hi all . Been plenty of wet weather recently and we attended 2 car accidents last week where people went off the road into fences so please be extra careful out there when driving. Wet roads can be deceptively slippery in some situations.

A vehicle had its side window smashed on High Street late afternoon one day last week. Police are looking at the town CCTV for clues.

A vehicle in Aranui Road Mapua had a side window smashed during the day on Monday and a purple/grey Macpac brand backpack was stolen.

Also on Monday in Mapua, a female in her mid 30's with long dark wavy hair and wearing a dark grey jacket was seen placing jewellery in her pocket while in a shop on the Wharf, but did return it when approached.

Motueka police attended 10 family harm incidents.

The front windscreen of a car was smashed at Riwaka and a timber yard in High Street was burgled.
