The Tasman District Council have received an application for a new bottle store in Mapua, across the road from Mapua School 🍷📄

The application for 'Super Liqour Mapua Village' has today been received by the TDC for 151 Aranui Road, in the complex also known as the Mapua Village.

The site, which was once home to the Mapua Tavern before it's sudden closure in 2015 is currently occupied by a second hand clothing store &amp; fruit and vegetable store.

In a licensing notice on their website, the TDC say alcohol is intended to be sold from "Monday to Sunday between the hours of 9.00am and 10.00pm." Currently, the nearest alcohol stockist is Four Square Mapua, 780m down the road.
