I have also put arrows on the AED boxes and some writing to indicate the side latches as in the rush to extract the AED the latches were wrenched open by force rather than released.

I think the event has sparked some interest, well particularly within the tennis club, so a little publicity about the event (after obtaining patient consent) might help attract more people to some instruction on AED use. Such training just on the AED use is something I am prepared to do although the other option would be proper CPR training with a mannequin which would be of some expense.
