I am just checking that the MDCA is aware of the Liquorland Mapua application for an Off-Licence for the (to be constructed) premises at 65A Aranui Road (registered proprietor being LMCH Limited with the sole director being Michael Henry Harvey, who will lease the premises), with submissions closing on Tuesday, 24 May (there appears to be some confusion in the community as there are currently two separate applications - the one by Super Liquor at 151 Aranui Road, Mapua and this application for Liquorland at 65A Aranui Road).

The Liquorland application appears to have 'flown under the radar' a little as the notice on the proposed site was put up on 11 May (after the MDCA public meeting), and objections/submissions close on 24 May (before the next MDCA public meeting). Unfortunately I do not have face book or would post the notice of application on that.

Submissions/objections in relation to this application close on Tuesday 24 May. I have attached a photo of the notice of application which is on the actual site and TDC has confirmed to me that notice was given on 3 May. I have a copy of the application and could drop it off to MDCA but do not have facilities to scan it.
