
### Māpua and Tasman Community Survey 2022


This survey was coordinated between the Māpua and Tasman Districts Community Associations from March 14 to April 15 by confidential email and paper entries. Number of responses = 319.

### Describing respondents


#### Age Group




- Roughly 10% of the local population responded to the survey with limited participation from those under 50 years old
- 51% of respondents were 65+
- Half of respondents have lived in the local area for 10 years or more:



People who moved here in the last 10 years came from the North Island, elsewhere on the South Island, from other parts of the Nelson Tasman area and overseas.



### They moved here for the lifestyle and 'village feel'




- Walking, gardening, cycling and swimming are the top activities people enjoy in this area.


#### What do you value about living in this area? Tick all that apply



## People who live here don't want to leave


 Less than half the respondents plan to move in the next 5 years and they want smaller homes


Less than one third of local residents are supportive of new housing builds in this area.

If residential development must proceed in Māpua and Tasman Districts area, would you rather see



What are your biggest concerns as a resident of the local area? Choose the top three.



Which of the following climate-friendly adaptations would you like to see in new builds in this area? Tick all that apply


