		 Fletcher (TDC Infrastructure Mgr will be providing this overall coordination. TDC assured me that all the different depts / project leads are talking to each other regularly, and that Dwayne's role is to ensure this keeps going. Tentative dates have been set for the November Community Engagement Sessions to be held at the Mapua Bowling Club, but these will not be confirmed until mid October (following a "Coordination Cmte meeting planning for next week) TDC recognize that given the level of activity in Mapua, together with a new Council coming in end CY22, February is not a hard deadline for completing the MSP as this may not be achievable. New councillors will need to be bought up-to-speed which will take time given all the other local body changes currently underway. They also recognize that it will be important to explain why certain choice/decisions are may prior to finalizing the MSP. 	
		 Local Govt Reforms An announcement is expect mid October regarding whether the plan to establish 14 Regional Planning Districts NZ-wide will be approved. If it is, then Marlborough / Nelson / Tasman area will likely be combined into a single Planning District. This mean there will be only one Regional Plan, Env Plan, FDC etc for this larger district. What this mean for these 3 separate councils, in terms of organisation, responsibilities and governance is still being discussed, with no additional info to share at this time. 	
		MDCA Constitutional Changes – The Executive are taking this opportunity to look at the constitution in its entirety and once this review has been completed will be placing the suggested amendments additions to the membership for discussion then agreement. MDCA Secretary Vacancy – We are still looking for someone to step up and join the team to serve our community.
