Hi Working Group,

We hope you are all keeping well. School holidays are almost upon us, so we wanted to give you an update on how things are progressing.

Last week we undertook a pre-construction site walk-over with TDC, the design engineer and the contractor. This was to highlight any final details we need to consider ahead of moving into the construction phase. On the engagement side of things, we had a great session at Mapua School today with the Principal, teachers, and students. They're excited to see things moving forward and improved safety for kids. Later this week we will be dropping flyers into all the letter boxes along Aranui Rd to keep people updated.

*Given we are now moving into the construction phase, **we will pause further Working Group meetings** until the pilot has been in place for a period. Once we've collected some feedback from the pilot (through further online surveys and pop-up events etc.), we will resume Working Group sessions towards the end of the year to look at design adjustments.*

We're working to the below programme:

Timeframe	Activity
<i>August/September 2023</i>	<i>Install pilot layout on Aranui Rd (construction duration 4-6 weeks)</i>
<i>October 2023 – January 2024</i>	<i>Gather feedback on the pilot (monitoring and evaluation plan in place)</i>
<i>November 2023 – February 2023</i>	<i>Review and design changes to pilot layout (involving working group)</i>
<i>March/April 2024</i>	<i>Adjust layout on Aranui Rd with further monitoring</i>
<i>June 2024 (Waka Kotahi funding period ends)</i>	<i>Project conclusion and summary back to TDC to inform future street design and permanent solution (later this decade)</i>

Thanks again for your involvement to date and we look forward all the feedback from the pilot.
