On behalf of the **Māpua & Districts Community Association** (MDCA) I wish to confirm that MDCA fully supports **Tasman Area Community Association (TACA)** in their ongoing planting efforts along **Te Mamuka Drive.**

Over the past year, thanks to generous grants funding and a dedicated group of local residents and community supporter, 12,000+ trees on 3 hectares of native trees have been planted on what was previously impenetrable gorse and blackberry-infested piece of land covered with wilding wattles and pine trees. Plans for 2024 include the planting of a further 11,000+ trees within Blocks 3 & 5 during the 2024 planting season.

TACA has a long history of active involvement in their community, and a proven track record of delivering on projects, including many planting, beautification and restoration initiatives undertaken entirely by community volunteers.
