Road resurfacing – SH60 Appleby – Motueka

Dear Resident/Business Owner,

One-way closure on SH60 for roadworks

Chipseal resurfacing work is planned on State Highway 60, from Appleby to Motueka between **Monday 9** and **Friday 20 October**.

While the work is in progress, a **one-way closure of State Highway 60 will be in place for people travelling from Nelson/Richmond to Motueka (westbound)**. The closure point on SH60 will be between the Moutere Highway, Appleby and Quayle St/Wharf Road Roundabout, Motueka.

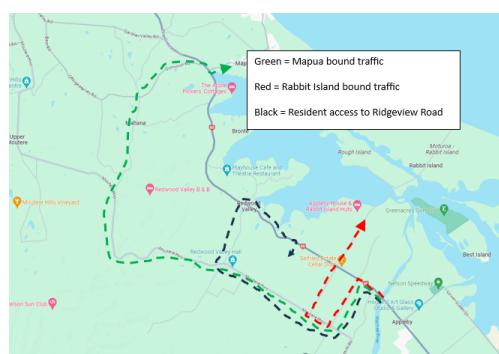
The other direction, from Motueka into Richmond/Nelson (eastbound) will remain open. While the work takes place, SH60 between the Quayle St/Wharf Road Roundabout, Motueka and Moutere Highway, Appleby **will remain open for east-bound** traffic (towards Richmond).

The work, associated closures and detour will take place from **Monday to Friday, 6AM to 6PM**. There will be no work over weekends. While SH60 will remain open in both directions during nights and weekends, traffic management and temporary speed limits will remain in place on SH60 to avoid stone-chip flicking up while the chipseal beds in.

If you are travelling from Nelson/Richmond to Motueka (westbound) during work times, you will need to take the local road detour. The approved detour route for all vehicles travelling from Nelson/Richmond towards Motueka is: turn left onto Moutere Highway, then right staying on Moutere Highway, continue on to Main Road Lower Moutere, right onto Wildman Road, left onto Quayle Street (previously High Street South), then left back onto State Highway 60.

Temporary speed limits and **stop/go** controls will be in place on the detour route at Thompsons and Redwood Valley Stream Bridges.

While local road users heading west towards Motueka will be detoured to Moutere highway, access to **SH60** will be possible from the detour route. However **there will be no opportunity to turn left (toward Motueka)**. While the work is in place you will need to always plan your journey via a route that does not require **Westward (Appleby – Motueka) travel on SH60**.

Nelson Tasman E-buses will continue to operate on their usual route through SH60, however there may be minor delays. School buses, where they have regular pick up or drop off points on SH60, will also continue their route through SH60.

How will this work affect you?

We understand this work will be a disruption to your usual journey. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience this may cause you.

For your safety and the safety of our road crews, please drive carefully and stick to the temporary speed limits in place.
