Hi Jim,

Apologies, I have been off sick since Friday morning so didn't manage to get back to you last week.

I have answered your questions as below.

1. What steps will be taken to address the community concerns about the safety aspects of the cycleways.

We will be releasing a post construction survey next month. This is the type of feedback we certainly want to hear as part of that. There are questions that specifically ask about safety. When it comes to actual safety incidents, it is extremely helpful if people can report this in as much detail as possible e.g. time of day, exact location, vehicles involved, what exactly happened. Any incidents already observed can be emailed to streetsforpeople@tasman.govt.nz.

2. How will the gutters will be cleaned behind the planter boxes?

Downer are responsible for road maintenance in the Tasman District. As part of their maintenance they would ensure that the necessary handwork is undertaken to clear behind planter boxes at the time the road sweeper comes through.

3. Who will be maintaining the plants in the planter boxes? The maintenance agreement with

Plant species have been selected that require minimal maintenance. Nelmac's maintenance contract would be extended to cover the maintenance of planter boxes too. If the community observe any issues with a lack of maintenance, we'd encourage them to reach out to TDC so that this could be followed-up with Nelmac.
