Councillors' Slot	 Impact of RMA Fast-track process on Māpua MasterPlan Summary of TDC email from Kim Drummond / Dwayne Fletcher Fast Track application from Tasman sought support from the FDS but there was no additional staff input into the legislation The Select Cmte report on the bill is due back Oct 18th) - as there were a large number of submitters, the Govt has already signalled it will be recommending changes. 	Councillors

- The TDC had no input into the proposals the developer made staff aware they were considering it but we did not include it in the mayor's letter or offer a letter of support as we thought it would prejudice the MMP process.
- The bill contemplates the EPA managing the process and its not clear what input council or the community will have (if any)
- The required Zoning changes are not scheduled to start until next year and the development consent(s) may not start to be processed until after that.
- The Development is now likely to proceed so the focus of the community and council should shift to what they would like and ensuring this is represented in the final masterplan, and use this document as a guide to council input into the consent process.
 - Christeen (councillor) spoke to the reply received to Paul's questions (in correspondence & summarised above). Question from floor re how much influence/control council will have. It is a unknow at this point in time- un til more info is shared by govt.
 - Māpua Masterplan It will be available for community feedback. Staff have been asked to consider the Christmas holidays re feedback timeframes.
 - Council is working on Plan Change 81 future strategy. Not considering sites in Mapua
 - Audit and Risk committee has appointed an external member
 - Reserve classification now looking at Richmond and St Arnaud wards
 - Council has made decisions re representation review. All will remain the same with the addition of the Māori Ward
 - Bylaws Being debated at the moment. Dog Bylaw has been pushed out as lots of submitters. Cat Bylaw and Public Places deliberation tomorrow. Concern from floor re 'used car lot' popping up on road reserve and appropriate bylaw. Suggestion to use Antenno to report.
 - 'Local Water Done Well' TDC need to come up with a plan within 12 months re our water management, to submit to government.
 - Dan (councillor) spoke re Dog Bylaw 1600 submissions and passionate speakers to many. Deliberations will be interesting
 - Question from floor re Marine Bylaws and where they were atunknown what stage this is at.
